Championship classes will be 5cm higher in the jump off round.

A Leaderboard of the events over the three days will be kept with a Champion Rug and medal being presented to the overall highest scoring rider. The second highest scoring overall rider will receive a saddle blanket and a medal with medals being presented down to fourth place.

The competition consists of a Combined Training event on Friday 16th December, a Two Phase event on Saturday 17th December and a Championship on the Sunday. Each horse is restricted to two height divisions.

SECTION 4 Longma Squad class summary



In March of each year the Jumping Victorian Young Rider Squads are selected. The selected riders are placed in four squads based on their performances for the previous season. Look out for the Application to be a part of this exciting initiative in Late January/February each year.

The squad training weekends consist of jumping lessons with many lectures and Guest speakers supplementing the program. We thank our coaches for this year- Jamie Coman, Adam Wootten, Paul Williams and Chris Smith for all their efforts. The coaches will be on hand this weekend to help riders warm up etc. We also thank our Sponsor Nicole Bernard from Longma for her companies generous support of the Young Rider squads for the past two years.

Every year there is a challenge event for the riders in each squad. Thanks to the sponsorship of Longma, the entry fee is at no charge for those riders qualified for each of the squads. There is a trophy rug for the winner of each of the four classes featured at this show.

SECTION 4 Inter Country Challenge



We welcome our International Teams for 2011 being New Zealand, South Africa together with the South Australian, Tasmanian and Victorian Teams. The rivalry between New Zealand and the Victorians is always keenly contested with the presentation of an annual trophy each year. The other states are always in the hunt for the Champion team. South Africa is new to this Challenge so we welcome these riders. This competition gives our Young Riders valuable experience in the format of Team competition which will stand them in good stead for National Senior Team events such as the Olympics etc.

The horses are borrowed so that the competition is fair to all. Event 5 will be the warm up event for our Team riders to familiarise themselves with their horses. Horses will be allotted to each team by a draw out of the hat to be conducted at the Teams Dinner on Thursday night.

Round 1 of the Teams Challenge will be held on Saturday evening as part of the Gala Night Program.

Each team will jump the first course with the worst score being discarded to give a team score. All riders will jump the shortened second course and again the worst score will be discarded to give a team score. The total score of the two rounds will be added together for placings of the teams. In the event of equality, the combined times of the three scoring riders will be added together to give each team a total time in order to split the placings. Presentation will be made to the three highest placed teams.

Round 2 of the Teams Challenge will be held on Sunday following the ISJ State Junior Title event in Ring 1. The format is the same as Round 1. Presentation will be made to the three highest placed teams.

We then present the Champion Team over the both rounds. The scores from each day are combined to give each team their score. In the event of a draw for first place, the teams will select one rider to jump off to decide first place. Rugs will be awarded to the winning team.

SECTION 5 Catering

Thursday night will be the official welcome dinner to our International Teams. This will be held at Santinis Restaurant. All are welcome. Meal costs will be paid for direct to restaurant. Please indicate on entry form if you wish bookings to be made for your family.

There will be a simple Welcome BBQ offered on Friday night consisting of sausage, coleslaw in bread etc for a gold coin donation to be paid on the night. Please book on entry form so we have an idea of numbers. This will be held during the Night Program in the Indoor.

On Saturday night there will be a Gala dinner. This will be a fantastic two course meal with a Christmas flair, soft drink and water supplied. The cost of this is \$40 per head. Bookings are essential. This will be held during the Saturday Night Program in the Indoor.

Conditions of Entry

- Just a reminder that we will be looking to all competitors and their families to assist in the running of **the rings. Whiteboards will be up at the secretary's office for the rosters at each ring. Your co-operation will be much appreciated as it is a condition of entry.**
- **Draws will be published at the secretary's office situated at ringside and displayed in Indoor.** Ring 1 will take precedence and, with no exception at any stage, will follow draw order. Ensure marshalls are aware if you have a problem.
- Competitions will be run under FEI rules together with the EA National Rules. These can be downloaded from www.equestrian.org.au under Rules-Jumping.
- Summer uniform may apply if deemed appropriate by OC or judges. This is polo shirts of predominantly one colour. In Championship classes full dress rules apply- jacket, shirt with tie or ratcatcher collar. Sleeves may not be rolled and sleeveless shirts are not permitted.
- All riders must be currently registered with the EV.(Junior type and above)
- No limit to number of entries per class but day limits for rings will be applied if required.
- Division A-D classes will have a leader board recorded. Riders will be ranked in each event and awarded points. The championship will be ranked with points allocated weighted by 1.5. The aggregate score over the three rounds will determine the overall scores. In the case of equality- the higher ranking in the Championship will be used to split placings.
- The 14yrs and under Championship is open to competitors that turn 14 years old in 2011 or younger. As these Championships were moved from April to December, it was decided that this disadvantaged riders who would have been eligible but turned 14yrs since. The age limit was opened up to include these riders so all riders 14yrs and below are eligible.
- A competitor is classed as a Junior for the State Title Event from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 yrs until 31st of December in the year of turning 18 as per Australian National rules.
- A competitor is classed as a Young Rider from the beginning of the calendar year they turn 16 until 31st of December in the year of turning 21 as per Australian National rules.

- Werribee Park Facility Fees Apply \$ 16.00 per horse per day or weekend rate of \$40 per horse. Camping is to be paid \$25 for unpowered or \$50 powered site. More information can be found direct from WPNEC website. Payment for camping can be paid to event secretary or directly to WPNEC as per attached form.
- You are asked to ensure you collect your prizemoney from the show prior to leaving. No prizemoney will be sent out.
- For stabling—please book in directly with Werribee Park on 97417672
