257.2.4	Saddlery - boots	<p>New rule</p> <p>For all young horse competitions and D grade/ 1.15m and under classes, all hind leg protections must have a maximum interior length of 16 cm and minimum exterior width of 5 cm:</p> <p>The following criteria must be respected:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The inside of the protection must be smooth; the fixations must be non-elastic Velcro; no hooks or straps may be used; • The rounded rigid part of the protection must be placed around the inside of the fetlock; • No additional elements may be used in conjunction with the protection. 		1/1/2012
283.2	Imported Horses	<p>Add wording</p> <p>“Imported horses must be assessed by the grading panel within 3 months of their importation.”</p>	<p>Foreign horses imported into Australia must be graded according to their age unless the owner can produce documentation to prove that the horse should be graded differently. Imported horses ages will be determined as at 1st January.</p>	1/1/2012
238.5	Speeds	<p>Change the speeds for all courses over 1.05m to be 350m/min</p>	<p>Speeds for D grade/ 1.15m and below were 325m/min.</p>	1/1/2012
