General Rules and Conditions

The event is to be run under EA rules as they are applicable to this event and shall include any other rules formulated by the organising committee. We strongly recommend that all competitors obtain a copy of the relevant EA Rules through the EV website www.vic.equestrian.org.au.

Entries

It is recommended that competitors retain a copy of their entries with proof of payment and bring this with them to the event, along with a copy of horse registrations and membership cards in case you are asked for proof of registration or membership.

Close of Entries

Entries close 4:00pm **Saturday 17th of February 2012**. No late entries will be accepted.

Acceptances:

An acceptance list will be posted on the RT Edgar Show Horse State Titles events page prior to the event. All competitors are required to ensure exhibit details are correct or notify the office if there is any query at least 1 week prior to the event.

Changes to submitted entries

Once you have entered, all changes to entries must be made in writing. Changes to entries will only be accepted up until **17th of February 2012**. After this date, absolutely no changes will be made.

Refund Policy

Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entries. Scratchings prior to the close of entries will incur a \$30 administration fee. In the event of a horse or rider being unfit to compete, a medical or vet certificate must be received by the office within 72 hours of the event. Certificates can be faxed to 03 9974 0577 or posted to Equestrian Victoria, Po Box 616, Werribee, Victoria 3030.

Membership and Horse Registration

All owners/riders must be current financial members of Equestrian Victoria. Forms can be downloaded from www.vic.equestrian.org.au, or membership can be applied for online. All horses must be registered with Equestrian Victoria. **INTERSTATE RIDERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO RIDE AT THE VICTORIAN SHOW HORSE STATE TITLES.**

Administration Fee

All Competitors must pay the compulsory, non-refundable administration fee of \$20.00 PER HORSE at the time of entry.

Security Levy

Over the past few years theft and vandalism at Werribee Park has increased to an unacceptable level. In order to protect the venue, sponsor signs and exhibitors equipment, the Committee has decided to set a fee to cover the cost of overnight security during the 2012 Show.

Exhibitors will be required to pay a compulsory Security Fee of \$6.00 per horse/pony entered.

Stabling and Facility Fee

Stabling can be booked directly through WPNEC online www.wp nec.com.au or 03 9741 7672.

Exhibitors will be required to pay a compulsory Facility Fee of \$16.00 per horse/pony entered, per day. This fee will be passed onto Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre

Measuring

All exhibits must hold a current Equestrian Victoria height certificate prior to competing in their class. These must be produced upon pick up of exhibit numbers.

The measuring stand will be open on Friday the 2nd and Saturday the 3rd of March. Times will be posted before the event.

Leading Rein Pony

Pony to be 12hh and under

(riders must be 5 years of age and under 8 years of age on the first day of the show.)

First Ridden

Pony not exceeding 12.2 hh

(rider to be under 12 years on the first day of the show)

Swabbing

The use of prohibited substances in your horse is not tolerated and riders must be aware that swabbing of horses will occur at random as well as winners.

Rider of the year classes

Riders may only compete in the class for which they are eligible. Age is at the first day of the show. Riders must have been current Equestrian Victoria members for **3 months prior to the first day of the show**. If a rider has competed in an EA Rider of the Year in the current year, they are not eligible to compete in another EA Rider of the Year show in the same year.

Horse of the year classes

(Including leading rein and show hunters) Horses and ponies must be EV registered and domiciled in Victoria. The horse will be eligible if it has been registered with EV for 3 months and domiciled in Victoria for 3 months.

If a horse has competed in a qualifying class at the EA Horse of the Year show in the current year in another state, it is not eligible to compete in another EA Horse of the Year show in the same year.

Prizes

Winners and runners up in the relevant classes will be expected to represent Victoria at the 2012 Equestrian Australia Show Horse and Rider Championships.

All Prizes (including cash prizes) must be collected on the day, if they are not collected, you therefore forfeit your prize.

Qualifications

Horses entered in Open Classes require qualifications as follows:

1 Championship

OR 2 Reserves championships

At any affiliated EV show in open or show hunter sections only.

Qualifications from the 5th March 2011 until the 1st March 2012

Class Restrictions

Horses are to be shown as either an Open or Hunter with the exception of Show Hunters are allowed to compete in the Leading Rein and First Ridden section.
