Entry Fee: \$ 30 per horse

*includes entry to Three Classes & Exhibitors Pass (Valid – Friday 13th February only)
The Exhibitor Pass will admit the exhibitor's horse transporting vehicle and all its occupants.
Only exhibitors able to produce an Exhibitors pass will be allowed entry to the venue, at no charge.*

Where an Exhibitors Pass cannot be produced the following admission charges will apply:

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries Close on Friday 12th December 2008 at 5pm or when classes are full - No refunds after entries close
- Exhibitors are required to provide their own exhibitor number. Exhibitor numbers will be available from the 1st February on the Barastoc www.barastocshow.com and EFA websites www.efavic.com.au
- A maximum of 200 horses will be accepted on a first-come-first-accepted basis.
- Entry Fees include GST
- Riders who are not financial members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia (EFA) must include an additional \$20.00, which will provide Public Liability Insurance on the day of competition only.
- The EFA membership number must be shown on the entry form, in the space provided. **(Note – Must be Junior, Senior or Show Horse membership. Official/supporter level of membership not accepted.)**
- Non-Members must complete Insurance Waiver Form available with entry form
- Events are open to all riders enrolled in primary or secondary schools throughout Victoria, who have attained at least E Grade standard in showjumping, with the Pony Club Association of Victoria (PCAV) or have attained at least Level 5 in showjumping, with the Horse Riding Clubs Association of Victoria (HRCV) or be approved by their school to compete at that grade.
- All riders must be currently enrolled at the school they represent.
- Current PCAV or HRCV Grading Card must be available for inspection on the day of competition, to verify grading. Competitors must be graded on the horse they are competing on. Non PCAV and HRCV members must complete the signed declaration on the back of this entry form.
- Pony Club and HRCV graded riders must compete in their own grading.
- The Committee reserves the right to eliminate any rider deemed to be riding in an incorrect grade.
- All riders must wear Australian Standards Association (ASA) approved helmets at all times when mounted.
- School shirt, tie, jumper, competition uniform or tracksuit top and saddlecloth (if available) must be worn with beige, fawn or banana jodhpurs, or coloured jodhpurs if part of school uniform.

PRIZES

Class 1 & 2 : Ribbons to sixth placing in all sections.

Class 3 : Sash for winners. Ribbons 2nd – 6th

Overall Champions: The overall winners of each section will receive a Rug (donated by Sheldene Park Rugs) and Barastoc Horse of the Year Show Medallion

1. Table AM7 (Grades A & B, C, D & E)
2. Power & Speed (Grades A & B, C, D & E)
3. Championship (Grades A & B, C, D & E)

NOTE: Subject to entries, A & B Grade will be conducted as separate competitions, within each class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Entry Fee: \$26.00 per entry (No refunds after entries close)

ENTRIES MAY BE RESTRICTED TO 100 HORSES

This event is designed to promote all round horsemanship ability; it takes the dollar value away as it is **not necessary** to have an expensive horse or gear to compete and is judged solely on the ability of the rider to compete all tasks. The event is to find the best "all round" competitor and will have a different judge for each section. It is not necessary to be a member of the Equestrian Federation of Australia to compete, but if not the \$20 Insurance day fee must be paid with the entry.

This event is open to all young riders between the ages of 14 and 18 years of age. The age of the riders is taken from the 1st January.

Phase 1 - Working Hunter Section (Height 75cm)	50 points
Phase 2 - Individual Ridden Section	25 points
Phase 3 - In Hand Presentation Section	25 points

After the first three (3) phases are completed the top six (6) riders in each age group will complete the Dressage Section (Phase 4) 50 points

To be ridden in a Snaffle Bridle, except in Phase 1.

Showjumping wings and rustic rails will be used for Phase 1.

Prizes:

The winner of each class will receive a Commemorative Jacket & Sash. The placegetters (2nd – 6th) of each class will receive a Sash

The overall Champion (from winners of classes 72 - 76) will receive a Crystal Trophy. The overall Champion will be the class winner with the highest points. If scores are equal, a count back will take place.
