- 1) Each nominee **MUST** be a Branch Committee Member.
- 2) Nominations should have a candidate statement of no greater length than an A4 page attached to this nomination.
- 3) Nominations shall be returned to the Public Officer of the EV, who shall act as the returning officer, at:

- 4) Both proposer and seconder of the nomination must be a current Senior or Senior Show Horse member of the EV.
- 5) In the event of there being more nominations than vacancies for any position, a secret ballot will be conducted at the first Branch Committee following the Annual General Meeting.
- 6) The Public Officer of the EV shall act as scrutineer for the purpose of any election.
- 7) In a secret ballot the final numbers shall remain confidential at all times.
- 8) It is the responsibility of each individual signing this form to ensure they are financial members of the EV and to ensure the form is received by the EV Office prior to the closing of nominations. If either of the above situations arises, the nomination will be deemed invalid.
